MALIBU WINE SAFARI

Here, guests can discover the beautiful wines of the Santa Monica Mountains and mingle with exotic animals (who just happen to be retired movie stars). A trusty guide and driver team leads the adventure on a custom-built, open-air safari vehicle. Stops along the way allow explorers to take in the scenery, taste local wines and get up and close and personal with zebras, camels, alpacas, bison and even Stanley the Giraffe.

RONALD REAGAN PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY

Perched on a mountaintop with sweeping views, the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library and Museum is one of Southern California's most unique and beautiful attractions. Guests are able to walk onboard the actual Air Force One aircraft, tail number 27000, which flew seven U.S. presidents. Other exciting exhibits include an exact replica of the White House Oval Office, as well as the Rose Garden and South Lawn. Also home to President Reagan and the First Lady's memorial site, where he was laid to rest on June 11, 2004 and she on March 11, 2016, the Reagan Library is truly an entertaining, exciting and educational museum for people of all ages.

THE CONEJO VALLEY BOTANIC GARDEN

One of the hidden gems of the area, the Conejo Valley Botanic Garden is 33 acres of natural terrain encircled by the city of Thousand Oaks. From the sweeping vistas at the peak of the garden through 15 breathtaking, hillside specialty gardens, and onto the hiking trail along the riparian stream, the Conejo Valley Botanic Garden is a destination not to be missed.

A striking monument to commemorate the various cultures and the beauty they offer the world, the Gardens of the World exists not only as a cultural contribution to the community, but as an educational tool. Stroll through the six gardens featuring a delicate balance and harmony of culture and magnificent vivid floral designs. Summer concerts can be seen in the amphitheater while enjoying a picnic on the lawn.

THOUSAND OAKS CIVIC ARTS PLAZA

The Civic Arts Plaza is the realization of a 20-year dream by Thousand Oaks citizens to provide a facility to house quality cultural activities. To date, over three million people have patronized the Civic Arts Plaza since its successful October 1994 grand opening. Designed by nationally renowned architect Antoine Predock, the three-acre city complex juxtaposes serene meadowland and park-like vistas with a bustling entertainment center.

STAGECOACH INN MUSEUM

The Stagecoach Inn in Newbury Park, California, originally known as the Grand Union Hotel, was used as a resting area for people who traveled from Los Angeles to Santa Barbara. It is California Historical Landmark no. 659 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The museum includes a replica of Timber School (originally built in 1889), the carriage house and blacksmith shop, a nature trail, and the 'Tri-Village', a small group of three houses: the pioneer house, the adobe and the Chumash village.

MAMBA SPORTS ACADEMY

Mamba Sports Academy is often called the Disneyland for athletes. The all-inclusive 96,000 square-foot facility offers a variety of sports programs and services for athletes of all ages and skill levels. From tactical training to their mindset development program, it's truly a one-stop-shop for athletes.

THE LAKES

Enjoy shopping and dining at restaurants such as Sabor Cocina Mexicana and Unami Burger, as well as year-round entertainment. This beautiful shopping center with its sparkling lake, manicured garden and sculptures, is located just steps from the Civic Arts Plaza.

Zuma Beach is a county beach located at 30000 Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) in Malibu, California.
